WARRANTY TERMS & CONDITIONS

If there is a fault with an item we have supplied and/or installed, this warranty is limited to the replacement of the faulty item or items only and shall not, in any event, include the cost of any others items or any consequential loss arising from the act of the replacement or otherwise, subject to the following conditions;

1. The fault must be reported to us within 28 days of it being discovered. We recommend that, where possible, this is done via email. You must allow us reasonable access, and at a reasonable time of the day, so that we can attempt to rectify the fault without any delay to yourselves.
2. All adjustments, seals, leadwork etc is only covered on products that have been installed by one of our installation teams.
3. In cases of repair, or replacement, the period of warranty shall only extend up to the limit of the original warranty.
4. This warranty does not extend to;
 - (i) - The modification, removal and/or repositioning of any part of the installation without our prior knowledge and approval.
 - (ii) - Any damage or fault which arises due to misuse, neglect or lack of maintenance by you or causes beyond our control i.e. fire, flooding, civil, disturbance, criminal damage and acts of war.
 - (iii) - Any claim(s) for unforeseen damage or loss of whatever nature which arises from failure of any part.
5. If you sell the property in which the installation has been carried out we will, on request, transfer the unexpired part of this warranty to the new owner. However, we do reserve the right to inspect the current condition of the windows and doors, and also consider any change in the property's use prior to agreeing to transfer the warranty.
6. Despite the rights set out above, our statutory and common law rights remain unaffected.
